Admission Notification-01/2022 Under National Educational Policy-2020 for Undergraduate Semester-1

It is hereby notified for the information of all eligible candidates that the admission to 1st Semester Bachelor Programme under (NEP) national Education Policy-2020 in the Government /Non-Government Degree Colleges affiliated to the University of Jammu falling under Summer and Winter Zone shall be made as under :-

- a) 01-08-2022 to 20-08-2022 (without late fee)
b) 22-08-2022 to 31-08-2022 (with late fee of Rs. 320/-)
c) The Vice-Chancellor may consider grant of late admission for 10 days after the expiry of last date as per (b) above on payment of Rs.2910/- as late fee. Further, the additional time window for the private affiliated colleges shall be 3 days after the expiry of last date as per (c) above on the payment of Rs. 2910/- as late fee i.e. upto 15-09-2022

The regular teaching work of the class shall begin from 22nd of August, 2022.

Eligibility Criteria for Admission to B.A./B.Sc./B.Com Semester-I

Admission to Semester-I of the undergraduate Course shall be open to a candidate having passed the Higher Secondary Part-II (10+2 pattern) examination of the Jammu and Kashmir State Board of School Education, CBSE or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto subject to the availability of seats & if otherwise found eligible.

Eligibility Criteria for Admission to B.B.A Course Semester-I

Admission to Semester-I of the undergraduate Course shall be open to a candidate having passed the Higher Secondary Part-II (10+2 pattern) examination of the Jammu and Kashmir State Board of School Education, CBSE or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto and has obtained at least 50% of the aggregate marks in the qualifying examination in case of General category candidates and 45% marks in case of SC/ST candidates.

Eligibility Criteria for Admission to B.C.A Course Semester-I

Admission to Semester-I of the undergraduate Course shall be open to a candidate having passed the Higher Secondary Part-II (10+2 pattern) examination of the Jammu and Kashmir State Board of School Education, CBSE or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto with mathematics as one of the elective subjects and has obtained at least 50% of the aggregate marks in the qualifying examination in case of General category candidates and 45% marks in case of SC/ST candidates.

P.T.O.

The main feature of the programme are:-

All Bachelor's Degree programme are full-time regular for the specified duration as per national Education Policy (NEP-2020), with Multiple Exit and entry systems at various stages after even semesters, from the academic session 2022 and onwards.

As per the UGC Guidelines for Multiple Entry and Exit in Academic Programmes offered in Higher Education institutions, candidates who secured a minimum CGPA of 7.5 in a three year Bachelor's Degree Programme shall be allowed to continue studies in the fourth year of the undergraduate programme to pursue and complete the Bachelor's Degree with Research / Honours.

Admission the different colleges, affiliated to the University of Jammu, shall be offered for different subjects under different streams, depending up on the subjects being offered in the concerned colleges, as per the eligibility criteria already in vogue.

Note:

1. The admission in the Govt. /Non-Govt. Degree College imparting instructions in undergraduate Course affiliated to the University of Jammu shall be made directly by the Admission committee of the college concerned on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in the qualifying examination & strictly as per other statutes.
