ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON VIGILANCE AWARENESS WEEK

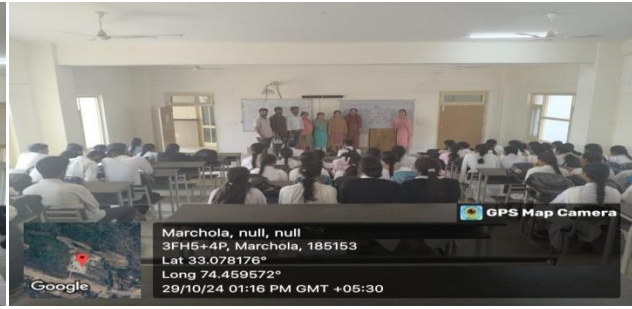
